### 1. Jog-A-Thon T-Shirts

- Gina Georgas T-Shirt Update
  - We have 6 top-tier sponsors for \$250 each. We are missing logos for three of them so we need to reach out to see if they want to send a logo or just want to use their name.
  - Current cost estimate for shirts is \$1649 (\$1298 last year). Pricing this year as follows: \$6.80 youth t-shirt, \$7.20 adult t-shirt, \$9.20 XXL size t-shirt.
  - The group suggested we might look at a sponsorship alternative to t-shirts next year since we barely cover the t-shirt expense cost yearly.
- Amy Tagles Update
  - We estimate we will have approximately \$1900 worth of sponsorship revenue which will cover the estimated cost of \$1650 in expense for t-shirts this year.

### 3. Lap Tracker Update – Denicia recreated the lap tracker form and will send the form to Jessica Yacoub in electronic format. Kelley Bowman will give a copy of last year's form to Denicia to make sure we don't miss anything.

### 4. Mr. Mark All School Incentive – We discussed having an incentive that involves active participation of the students such as a dunk tank, water soaker or water balloons.

### 5. PTSO Documents

- Terry Humphreys volunteered to create a google docs account for PTSO and work with Mercedes to get all PTSO documents housed in this location for ease of use, updating and transferring to new volunteers each year.
- We will save all future documents created in this same location.

### 6. Food Donation Jog-A-Thon

- Tara Scotti confirmed that Albertson's would donate 1 case of bananas, 1 case of oranges and 4 20 lb bags of ice. Jessica Yacoub said she could help store ice at her house prior to Jog-A-Thon.
- Tara Scotti will reach out to El Rancho to see if they will donate dixie cups and popcicles.

### 7. Volunteers for Jog-A-Thon Event

- Food and Water Prep – PTSO
- Set up tables and pop up tents – Need minimum 4-6 volunteers
- Lap Tracker volunteers – Need minimum 6-8 volunteers per grade
- Clean up – Need minimum 4-6 volunteers
- Counting of forms, laps and money – Jessica will work with a selected group during Jog-A-Thon in Mercedes office
- Jessica Yacoub will work with Mercedes to send out a ParentSquare email with these volunteer sign up opportunities

### 8. Prizes/Jessica Yacoub

- Grades 4-8
  - Most laps = \$50 prize
  - Highest sponsorship dollars brought in = 2 tickets to Knott's Berry Farm (\$45/child ticket, \$75/adult ticket)
  - Class with the most sponsors = \$50 ice cream sundae class party
  - Run a mile in Jog-A-Thon = run day pass
  - Turn in your sponsorship form with parent signature and/or sponsorship dollars = homework pass
  - Runner with the most Dragon Spirit = \$5 prize
- Grades K-3
  - Most laps = \$50 prize
  - Highest sponsorship dollars brought in = 2 tickets to Knott's Berry Farm (\$45/child ticket, \$75/adult ticket)
  - Class with the most sponsors = \$50 ice cream sundae class party
  - Runner with the most Dragon Spirit = \$5 prize
- All School Raffle
  - Every student who participates in the Jog-A-Thon (turns in parent signed form, runs/walks Jog-A-Thon, raises money) is eligible for the All School Raffle
  - Between 10-20 prizes will be awarded
  - Prizes = donated gift cards and small items totalling \$100
