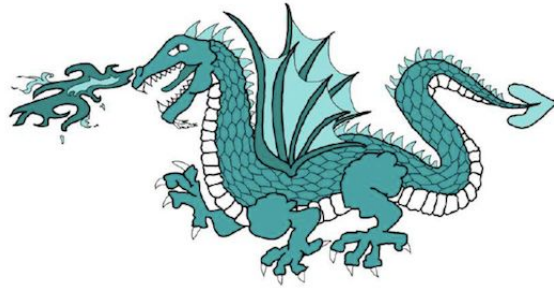


Tuesday Folder
