a. Treasurer's Report

Report included in packet. Nothing significant at the present time as pertains to the fund Balance. MS asked about the tree trimming. JD clarified that no trees were cut down but the tree company gifted the school some stumps that are now arranged along the side of the field.

b. Director's Report

Report included in packet. School is a buzz with the holiday show - this Thursday at 10:15.

Open enrollment begins in February and the ad (created by Kevin Donnelly) that is going to be released to the newspapers is enclosed in the packet. The Annual Appeal is at \$36,800 and 92%. Expect 100% participation by the end of the year. JD has not been using the work from home part of his contract at the rate that he expected (on about 8 at this point).

RU agreed that from the middle school perspective it is working well. EP agrees from the elementary grades as well. KK just wanted to check in at this point in the year since that was a part of the contract being approved. College School District requests JD to attend

their upcoming board meeting on Tuesday, December 13. CT and RU will attend as well. The district would like to ask questions regarding the MOU and the budget and the decision to begin our own TK. The Halloween early release time was questioned by a parent. KK suggested that having the early released all marked on the official calendar at the beginning of the year.

7) Informational/Discussion

a. Proposed 'town hall meeting' with middle school parents to gain feedback KK explained the hope of getting information. Staff are not required to attend. The plan is a date in January at BT's home. Some concerns that it could turn into a gripe session. KK reassured that the discussion will be guided carefully. Suggestion to ask the parents of younger grades for their expectations re: middle school. NB reminded the board that there used to be a meeting for 4th grade parents so they know what to expect with their student entering middle school in 5th grade. MS suggested having exit interviews with the 8th graders.

Unfortunately, 55% yes votes needed, but only got 52.2% yes votes. We would need about

169 votes which seems unlikely in the remaining uncounted ballots. Plan to put similar measure on the ballot in 2024.
