# **CONGRATULATIONS!!! Let's Put It All Together!**

Key of A (capo #1) 12 Bar Blues

### *LET'S MAKE THE CIRCLE SONGS BETTER!*

As you know many songs are bigger and have more parts than our circle songs. Let's explore that a bit...

Verse (V) - Tells the story of the song.

Chorus (Ch) - That's the repeating part that everyone can sing along to (Sweet Home Alabama).

Bridge (Brg) - That's the part between, after or before the other parts. It typically sounds a little different.

Pre Chorus (PreCh) - A part that goes before the chorus

Post Chorus (PCh) - A part that goes after the chorus

Intro (Int) - It goes before or is the beginning of a song.

Outro (Out) - Yep! It's the end of the song.

Arrangement - That is the order in which all these parts go.

Many times you might see an arrangement like this:

Int/ V/ Ch/ V/ Ch/ Brg/ Ch/ Out

Our first song will be a bigger circle song just to stretch our brains and fingers a bit. Try to memorize the circle.
