This week we again highlight Goal 3 of our LCAP: Santa Ynez Valley Charter School will create a supportive school climate where students develop social skills through schoolwide buddy programs and active community involvement. There are a few aspects of this goal that I'd like to share: **tardies/attendance, assemblies, buddy/family activities, and student support.** Last week we shared about the first three topics, today I'll share more about our **Student Support Services.** This is our second year partnering with People Helping People to bring a Student Support Specialist to campus. Ms. Meg is this person for the 2017-2018 school year, your children also knew Ms. Beth last year. She provides individual student support, in the moment (on the playground) group support, provides classroom lessons, and works with our staff to support individual student needs. Many of the growth opportunities for our children centered on improving communication with peers, ways of calming themselves when stressed, and conflict resolution skills.
