Students in Grades 5 and 8 take Science Test; and 5th and 7th Graders take PE tests. This is the time for all students to celebrate what they have learned by doing their best on these tests. Scores are typically mailed out in August around the time we return from school, which can show you the progress your child has made over the past year. We'd encourage you to make sure your child is well rested, on time to school, and that you discuss with them their goals for the tests this year. The week of May 21, after the State Tests, 8th graders will have a busy week preparing for high school with both the SRI (Reading Test) and the Math Diagnostic Test which, along with grades, will help place students in the correct classes at the high school.

SYVCS Egg Drop Contest
Principal for the Day: Grant Hodgdon
Wednesday, May 16, 2018

Rules for the Egg Drop Contest:

1. The device must be able to protect an egg from breaking after falling from between 1 and 10 stories high.
2. The device must not exceed 8" cubic area (8" x 8" x 8").
3. The following requirements are given for the loading of the device:
 - a. The devices should not be loaded with an egg before the competition.
 - b. All devices should be designed to be easily loaded on the day of the event.
4. The following materials are not allowed in the design:
 - a. Any type of parachute contraption (designs must be able to free fall)
 - b. Packing peanuts
 - c. Metals (except for conjunction items such as screws, staples, paperclips, etc.), glass, chemical containers, Styrofoam (with the exception of whole Styrofoam cups), and thick wood (such as 2x4) and any food products.
5. Student(s) must bring their device on Wednesday, May 16 to school.
6. Each device will be weighed before being dropped.
6. The contest will be held on Wednesday, May 16 at 11:30am for grades K-5 and 12:15pm for grades 6-8.

Judging Criteria:

A panel, selected by the Principal for the day, will judge the devices according to the conditions mentioned below.

1. The egg remains intact. If any of the egg's contents spills, the design is disqualified.
2. The egg which survives the highest fall is considered the winner. If there is more than one device which qualifies to be the winner, the judges will determine a winner based on the weight of the device. The lightest device will be declared the winner.

Additional Awards:

Humpty Dumpty Award – the device with the egg that breaks in the most spectacular fashion
Eggelicious – egg drop device that is aesthetically pleasing to the judges
