SYVCS End of Year Beach Day

To celebrate the 2017-2018 School Year as an entire school, we are planning and End of the Year Beach Day at Refugio Beach.

Because of your great support for our school, PTO is able to pay for lunch, lifeguards, parking passes for parents driving other students, and a bus for transportation.

Timelines: All students and drivers will come to school at 7:55am. Following the flag salute, we will plan to leave school by 8:30am. All students will return to school by 3pm.

What to bring: Please dress in layers, as the beach may be cold. Bring a bag/backpack with bottled water, towel, sunscreen, and a change of clothes. Please do not bring electronic devices. If you are driving and can fit beach toys in your car, your child is welcome to bring them. Extra toys for the beach won't fit on the bus for those riding the bus.

Transportation: Transportation will be provided by parent volunteers and a bus from Santa Barbara Transportation. Drivers are to leave SYVCS and go directly to Refugio Beach.

We will load the bus first, then have parent drivers pull through the car line and staff will load students just like the pick-up line.

Car Seats: If your child rides in a car seat, please bring your child's car seat to school with their name on it. Your child will not be able to go to the beach without their car seat.

Water Safety: We have hired 2 lifeguards to ensure safety of students in/around the water. If your child is not allowed in the water (as marked on the permission slip), they will wear a colored wristband to show everyone they are not to be in the water. All adults in attendance are also asked to supervise children at the beach.

Snack/Lunch: A fresh fruit snack will be provided mid-morning. For lunch, we will provide a hot dog lunch, chips and water. Please check with Mr. Mark for a vegetarian option. Your child should bring lots of water with them.

Dress: Please dress in layers as the beach may be cold. Also, please keep in mind that this is a school activity, don't forget to bring your extra t-shirts and/or beach cover-ups.

Refunds for most fieldtrips are not guaranteed as pricing and reservations are based on numbers.

In the event of an accident or other emergency, when a parent is not available, I hereby authorize a representative of the school to make such arrangements as he/she considers necessary for my child to receive medical or hospital care including transportation. 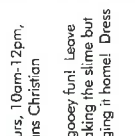
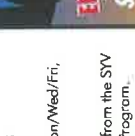
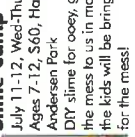
