Dear Dragon Families,

Today I was looking over the draft of the Graduation Program, and had a moment to reflect on some of our end of year traditions that make our school so special. I wanted to share with new families, and reminders for experienced families, of how our work together helps celebrate our children's successes. Here are a few of the traditions (not all) that you will see from now until the end of the year:

8th Grade/Staff Kickball Game (May 31, 1-2pm) Our annual athletic competition where 8th graders attempt to win against our Teachers, Board Members, and Coaches. Come cheer the 8th graders on! We will distribute yearbooks and have a yearbook signing after the kickball game.

Awards Assembly (June 1, 9am). While the main awards are given to 8th graders for academic achievements, other awards such as Student Council and Perfect Attendance are awarded to students in any grade level. If your child is going to receive an award we send an email about a week early to invite you to join us. 8th Graders are encouraged to be checked out after the awards assembly to join their families for a nice lunch.

Beach Day (June 4). This has been a great way to celebrate as an entire school one last time. We will be going to Refugio this year with Bus Transportation, Lunch, Lifeguards, and parking for parent drivers paid by PTSO. This is a regular school day, so if your child is not interested in going to the beach, they are expected to be at school and activities/supervision will be provided for them here on campus.

8th Grade Class Trip (June 5). Each year the 8th grade class picks a place to go for their 8th grade class trip, this year they are going to Magic Mountain!

Graduation Practice (June 6-Early Release). 8th Graders attend school for a very short period of time (typically 10am-11am) to practice. All students K-7 will be released at 1pm on June 6. This day we practice our graduation ceremony so we are all ready for the big day! This is an important for all students to attend so they are ready to give their best gifts to the graduation class.

Graduation (June 7, 9am). Our Graduation is a culmination of our values as a school. It represents our commitment to community, Buddy Programs, academics, and celebrating the graduating class of 2018! 8th graders pick the theme annually, with this year being "Hollywood". Our K families have an important role to set up the stage. 7th grade families are responsible for clean up, so that when their children are in 8th grade they don't have to stay to clean up. And 8th grade families are responsible for the set-up and decorations. Each and every student has an important role in the ceremony...they create, practice, and perform a gift (song, dance, or poem) that they "give" to the graduating class at graduation. One of the most special gifts are the poems written about each 8th grader and read at graduation. I can't express how important your child's role is (regardless of grade level), but in particular the 7th grade poems are, to our 8th grade students and families. Our graduation is a can't miss event for everyone!

We are getting very close (9 days) until our 8th graders are ready to hear the Dragon Song and get their wings...until then...we have lots of work to help support and celebrate them!
