Drop-Off and Pick-Up: Please take the time to review our procedures (attached) for drop-off and pick-up. These are essential to keeping your child safe, being great neighbors, and the efficiency of our pick-up/drop-off times.

Sports Camp: During the first full week of school, August 21-24, students in grades 1-4 will have early release (1pm) days. We are offering a Sports Camp from 1pm-3pm Monday-Thursday for students in grades 1-4. In order for us to provide adequate adult supervision, we have limited number of spaces to 30 students. We ask that a small donation of \$5/day per child be made to the school to help defer the cost of Sports Camp. Your child must be signed up for Sports Camp on/before August 14 on ParentSquare.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures

We have established pick-up procedures to make sure everyone is safe, and that our pick-up line takes 10 minutes or less each day. Thank you for respecting the following procedures:

Drop-Off

Students should be dropped off in the right lane of Tyndall Street Drop-Off.

The left lane will be used only for drive thru.

The College School District Parking lot, and bus turnout on Pine Street are not to be used to drop off students at any time.

Pick-Up

Any student walking home from school needs to leave campus immediately following school, unless they are involved in an after school activity.

All students being picked-up from school will be waiting by the gate near the flagpole. Students will be seated by class.

Students will be picked-up in the right lane of the pickup line only.

Students will be loaded into the first three cars in the line only. No student should be picked-up further down the line.

Staff members will be present to help your children get into your car.

If your child is not ready when you come to the front of the line, a staff member will direct you to a waiting area until your child arrives for pick-up.

The left lane will be used for drive thru only.

When everyone follows these procedures, pick-up for all students will take less than 10 minutes.

Important Reminders

The left lane of the car line is for drive thru only, not for pick-up or drop-off.

The car line is not a parking area, if you need to get out of your car for any reason, please find a legal parking spot on Tyndall or Pine Street.

The College School District Parking lot, and bus turnout on Pine Street are not to be used to drop off students at any time.

Please be respectful of our neighbors by not blocking their driveways or walkways when you park.

The end of Tyndall Street is a county-marked no parking zone.

Students should not be hanging out at the corner of Tyndall and Pine Street. Students waiting for a ride need to remain on campus at the gate with their class.

Any students remaining on campus following the car line will be expected to wait at the lunch tables for their ride to come.

The area around campus is a school zone, with posted speed limits at 25 mph.

Please pay attention to any directions that staff members may give to help direct traffic, keep children safe, and keep the car line moving efficiently.
