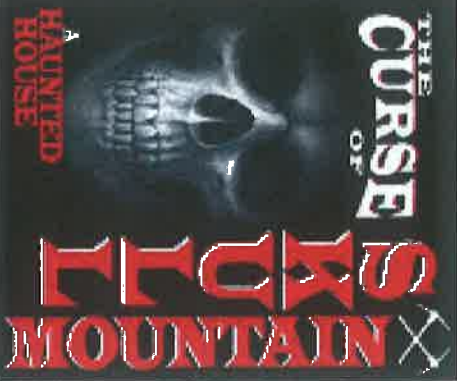
## AUTUMN ADVENTURES and Much More!

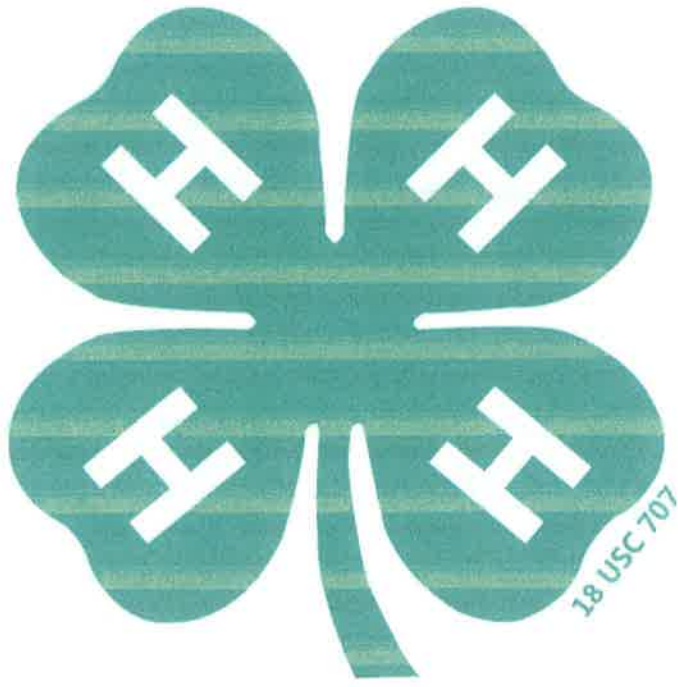
